RECOMMENDATIONS:

(1) That definite rules be laid down to control the Necessary civilian traffic on aerodromes.

(2) That pupils sign as having read the extract from Command Instructions, (Appendix "C"), at the time they are recommended to act as safety pilots.

(3) That the seriousness of flight authorizations be thoroughly impressed on personnel concerned!

PRIMARY CAUSE:

NEGLIGENCE OF DECEASED. (CIVILIAN)

The victim was walking on the runway near the left edge with his back to the oncoming aircraft and thus did not see it. The Pilot of the Aircraft allowed it to swing to the left and failed to see the man soon enough to avoid hitting him.

ACTION TAKEN:

(A) DISCIPLINARY (B) TECHNICAL (C) OTHER

Instruction and pupils put on charge.

Pupils dismissed.

Instructors case not disposed of immediately.

SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:
