NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT:

A/C WAS FORCED TO LAND PARTLY CROSSWIND ON AN ICY RUNWAY WHICH WAS NOT SANDED, DUE TO A CRASHED USAAF FORTRESS HAVING CRASHED ON THE UPWIND RUNWAY. BRAKES FAILED TO HOLD ON ICY SURFACE AND A/C SLID OFF END OF RUNWAY.
