No apparent technical defect.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Pupil authorized to carry out solo exercises - turns, glide approach and landing and precautionary landing. After completing these exercises, he returned to base and carried out wheeler landing. A/C bounced and on touching down again, pupil used brakes harshly and A/C nosedover on its back.
