Pupil throttled back in preparation for spin and engine stopped. Instructor took control, checked cockpit and found nothing to cause failure. Dived to 2000' in attempt to start engine to no avail, force landed successfully. In attempt to takeoff (authorized) mud was thrown by wheels damaging propellor.
