NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

While taxiing a/c 8264 on taxi strip into parking area, the a/c had the tendency to swing to the right. When left brake was applied to correct this, the left brake did not hold. When pilot noticed that he was getting close to the line of parked a/c he cut switches and applied full right brake in attempt to ground loop the a/c. A/C ground looped and port wing of a/c 8264 hit rudder of a/c 7226.
