

PURPOSE OF FLIGHT: TECHNICAL OFFICER'S REPORT: 1220/P31/2N Low level navigation exercise for Nil navigator and bomb airmers. NATURE OF ACCIDENT: Apparently flying too low, struck tree COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT: top and then went out of control and FINDINGS: SUMMARY No. 2131 hit the ground, demolishing a/c. The Investigating Officer found that "the cause Pilot had been following another A/C of the accident is not clear" but gave some credence which was about five miles ahead. to the theory of the a/c having been caught in a down draft. Note: Air was bumpy in area and a/c was flying in lee of higher ground, where there was possibilities of down drafts occurring. Also suggested that slip stream of preceding a/c would contribute to air turbulence. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. and CLASSIFICATION: Flying below authorized altitude for exercise/could 16. Unauthorized low flying or not have been keeping sufficiently sharp lookout. aerobatics.
