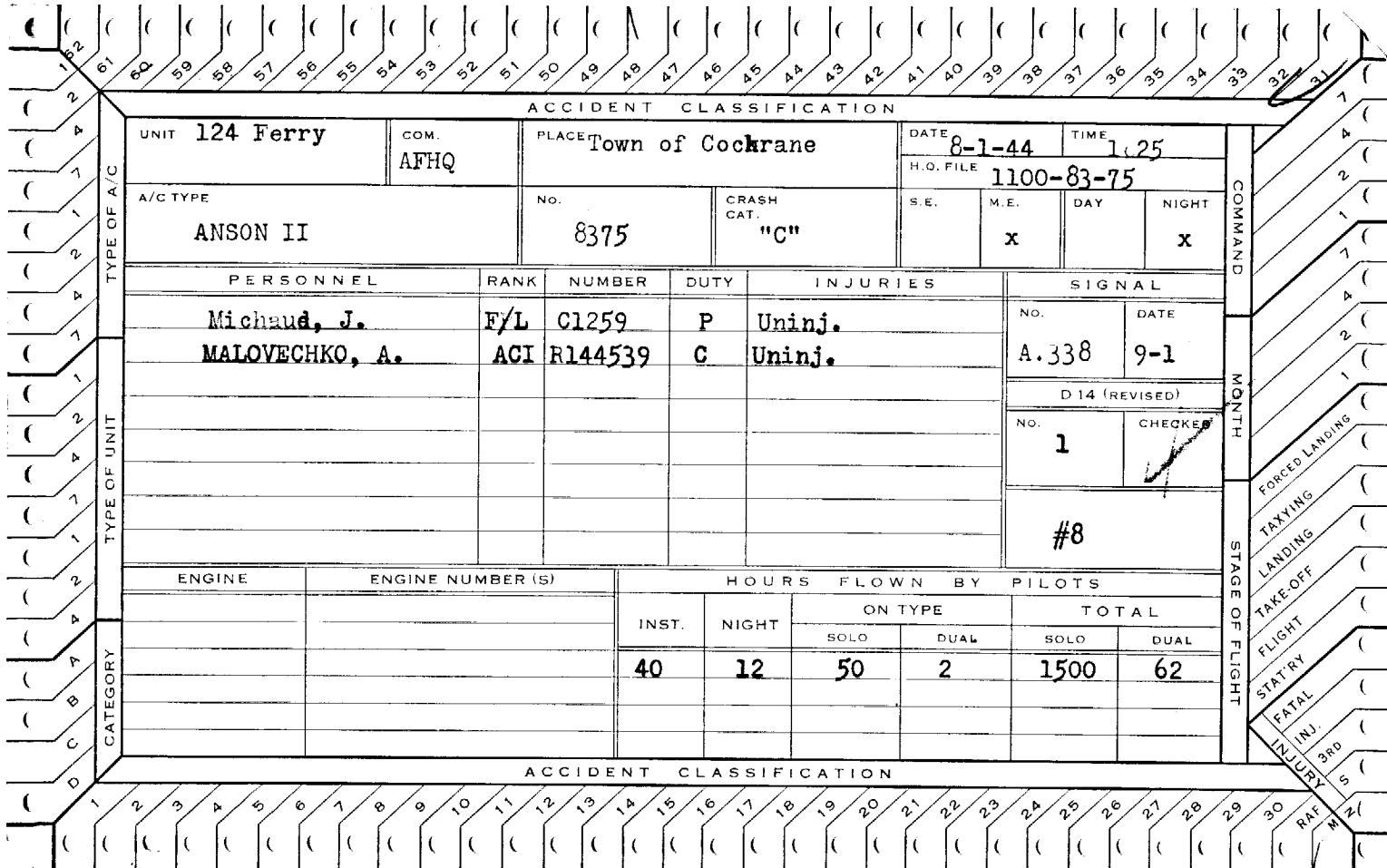

COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT:

Ferrying a/c from North Bay to Kapuskasing. Delayed in taking off and later ran into adverse weather (snow flurries) at Timigami, following leader became lost, got separated, and as storm became worse, located a railway which lead him to Cochrane where he eventually made a forced landing in heavy snow in a field damaging both props.
