Findings of Investigation

Canso 11022 taxied past Canso 11015 and struck a telephone pole with Stbd mainplane. Pilot dismissed the telephone pole too easily from his mind consequently used a poor judgement in taxiing. The paving of corner area is now complete. Pole is to be painted but obstruction light is not felt necessary as the taxi directors are now responsible for clearance beyond this area.
