PURPOSE OF FLIGHT:

Routine night training flight.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Pilot just clear of ground on take-off when violent depression to left wing occurred, with swing to left. Power had to be reduced to maintain control and as the chances of climbing away seemed remote, pilot closed throttles and landed. Applied left rudder to avoid running out of field and ground looped to left, collapsing left aileron and breaking left propeller.
