NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Pilot reports that on take-off, when at 50', the engine failed and he landed the a/c straight ahead but could not stop the a/c rolling forward until it had gone through the fence at end of runway in use. When a/c went through the fence, the stabalizer caught the fence post damaging same.
