Broken rocker bracket, Port engine #4 cylinder.  
(Chronic failure).

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Port motor would not develop any power in lean mixture - 1550 r.p.m. in rich mixture. Pilot climbed to 7500 feet using all power from both engines, then throttled back port motor and return fo base on single engine.
