PURPOSE OF FLIGHT:

Navigation and air bomber training.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

In lean mixture, port motor began to miss and lose 300-400 r.p.m.'s
In rich mixture picked up and then dropped 600 r.p.m.s. Pilot cut motor back and turned to Brandon airport. Port motor cut out completely on final approach. Landing was made without any damage.
