Bolingbroke 9900 came to a full stop on taxi strip to allow an Anson to taxi out from hangar area to taxi strip. Bolingbroke 10184 taxiing 60' to rear was taxiing in such a manner and speed that pilot did not have complete control of the a/c and failed to stop a/c in time, colliding with Bolingbroke 9900 causing damage to both a/c.
