The a/c was Command Investigating Officer. equipped with R/T facilities but no communication was received by the tower or by anyone of any engine or other failure in a/c 6711 before it crashed. At CLASSIFICATION: time of crash. a/c was proceeding in a direction 19. Cút of control. away from base and apparently had passed several fields suitable for forced landing if such had been necessary.
