CIRCUMSTANCES.; Examining Officer was giving a wings Test to pupil. Apparantly forced landing tests being made when accident occurred. A/C crashed into side of a hill.

<u>CAUSE</u>: Attempted forced landing - whether "Prectice or "Real" cannot be determined at this time.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Nil.

CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B.: A/C crashed and burned during

a flight in which an experienced instructor was giving wings test to pupil. - cause obscure.

Probably the student was being tested on forced landings at the time of the accident as the location of

the crash is within the forced landing area, but whether or not real or practice forced landing was being carried out, there is not sufficient evidence ACTION TAKEN: to determine the cause of the accident
