5 hour solo cross country.

FINDINGS:

SUMMARY No. 2453

CAUSE: For some obscure reason, pilot bailed out of a/c permitting it to crash land; he, failing to pull parachute, was fatally injured.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Nil

CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. The cause of this accident is obscure but the evidence does indicate that fire occurred in air and that the pupil, through panic attempted to abandon a/c.
