LUC /PCDUW / UCD L NATURE OF ACCIDENT: Pilot states: Took off in AJ593 at COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT 0055 and carried out vital actions FINDINGS: SUMMARY No. after take-off, climbed to circuit height and turned onto downwind leg O rather near to flare path; did vital action late and noticed u/c lights flick onto green while signalling for permission to land Turned onto crosswind leg and did vital actions but owing to throttle

approach low with considerable power and resumed the three point attitude while CLASSIFICATION:

closing throttle. Horn blew

but before corrective action could be taken the machine had touched down on tail wheel lowered itself bumpily onto its nose and turned at a considerable angle to the flare path before coming to rest.

## SECONDARY OR CONTRIBUTORY FACTORS:

sticking was not able to close fully. Made
