PURPOSE OF FLIGHT:

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

A/C struck ground at 25 degrees to horizontal. At least one engine was running full revs. A/C then skidded in a direction tending to port for 500 yards and ended inverted.

FINDINGS:

SUMMARY No. 2465

CAUSE: Inability to maintain equilibrium on instruments under adverse weather conditions in or about cloud. Possibility of engine failure while flying straight and level or letting down to pin-point cannot be overlooked. In any event, pilot was definitely unable to cope with the conditions existing.

RECOMMENDATIONS: (1) An immediate investigation of administration in flying training wing detail be instituted under direction of 2 TCHQ having special ref. to met. briefing and ceased training checks of pupils. (2) That continued emphasis be made on the instruction directing pupils not to enter into or fly above an over-cast unless able to see distinguishing marks on the ground below.

CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B.: Agree with findings.
