PURPOSE OF FLIGHT:

Night Flying Instruction.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Pilot unable to counteract drift on take-off, tried to jump a/c into air but had insufficient airspeed to stay airborne. Wheels hit snowbank violently swinging a/c to stbd. U/C knocked off, wing spars broken. No moon, wind direction and speed variable from 300° to 315° true at 22 m.p.h., give a maximum drift of 35° port and a minimum of 20° port. Other pilots stated that this crosswind did not effect take off in any way.
