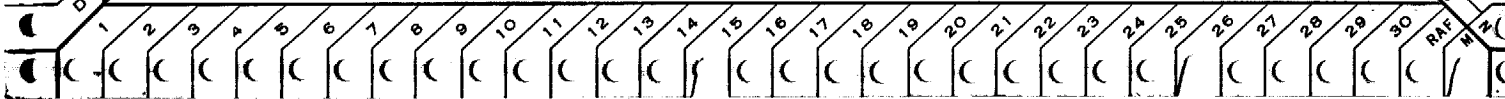

NATURE OF ACCIDENT:

Port engine failed immediately after take-off Pilot feathered propeller, but was unable to maintain climb and landed straight ahead. Weather CAVU No moon.
