That the pilot exercised poor judgement in not attempting to reach and alternate aerodrome after CLASSIFICATION: elapse of E.T.A. and receipt of special weather report. 19. Out of Control. 4. That no record of attendance at pre-flight briefing is kept by unit. 5. That pre-flight breifing leaves much to be desired at this Unit. 6. That W.D. Sgt.
