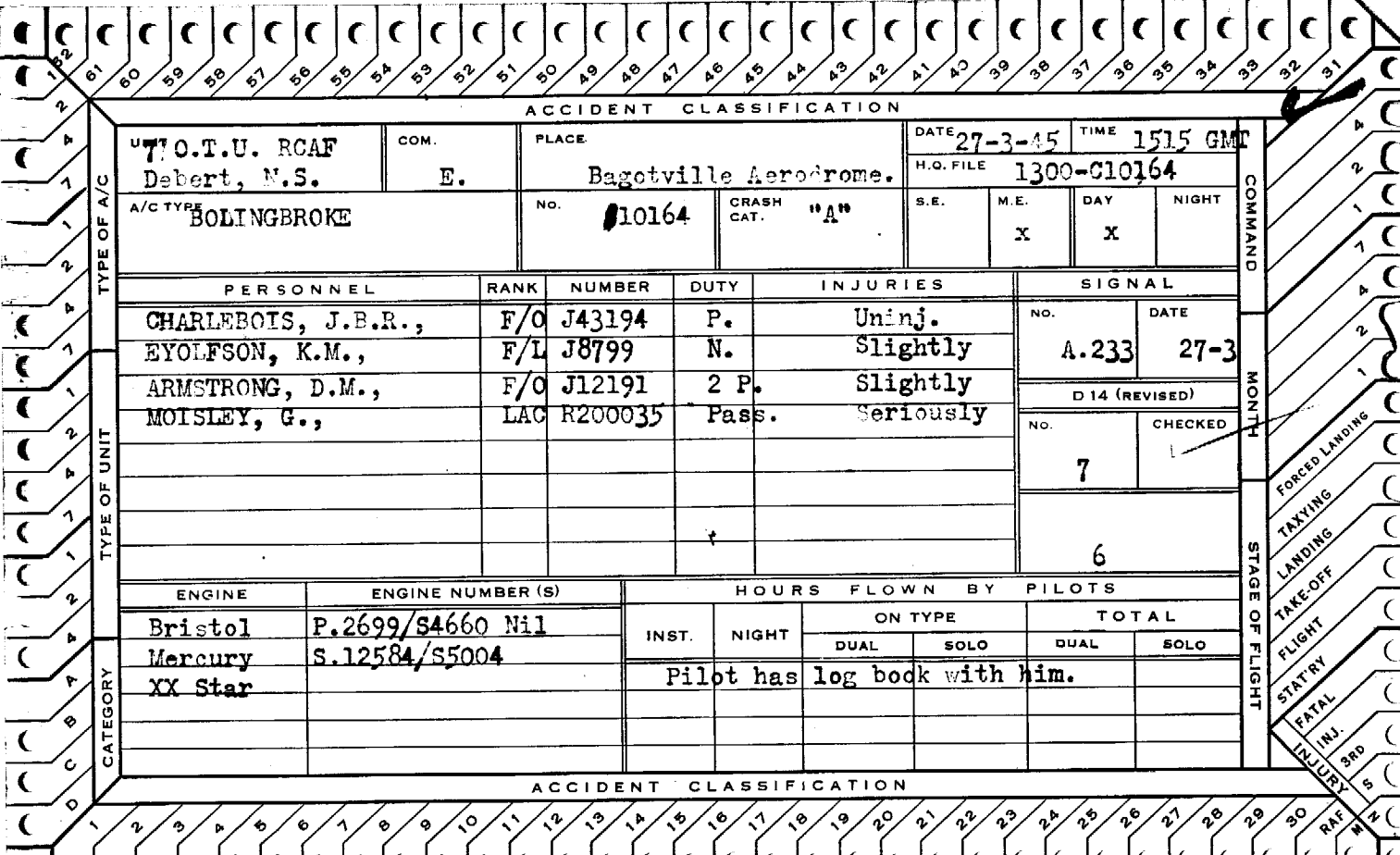

SUMMARY No. 2554

CAUSE: Pilot error combined with inefficiency of N.C.O. on duty in Flying Control Tower.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Nil.

REMARKS OF A.S.O.1: In my opinion it is a clear cut case of carelessness on part of pilot and inefficiency of Flying Control. Crash truck and ambulance should have been at the tower before the a/c attempted to land. It was Flying Control's job to keep the a/c in the air until such time as the above-mentioned vehicles were summoned. I suggest the Pilot's Log Book be endorsed for gross carelessness and appropriate disciplinary action be taken against whoever was responsible for Flying Control at that time.
