Riddell, president collided with the Wind Indicator S/L I.A. Critchley, member Tower. causing aircraft to dive F/O C.J. Collins, member into ground. RECOMMENDATIONS: Officer i/c Night Flying should not be below the rank of F/L. More specific orders should be issued to ensure PRIMARY CAUSE: that all structures e.g. the wind indicator should! Pilot flew in at an unnecessarily be regarded as aerodrome obstructions and should be low altitude. therefore lighted at night.
