Heavy landing.- Pupil attempted a landing first solo, striking ground heavily on wheels and then bouncing, slighting second time on one wheel and wing tip.

PRIMARY CAUSE: Heavy landing by pupil on first solo.

SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Aircraft bounced. Dropped a wing and landed heavily on one wheel and wing tip.
