WHEN INSTRUCTOR BEALIZED THEY HAD NO ELEVATOR CONTROL. INSTRUCTOR IMMEDIATELY TOOK OVER THE CONTROLS AND TRIED TO STRAIGHTEN THE A/C WITH THE AILERONS. HE SUCCEEDED BUT COULD NOT LEFT NOSE OF A/C.	RECOMMENDATIONS:  THE LOW FLYING REGULATIONS BE MORE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
