NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT:

Undercarriage retracted after
landing with wheels fully down.

AIRCRAFT LANDED WITH U/C NOT FULLY IN DOWN
POSITION. RAN ON WHEELS FOR A SHORT DISTANCE
THEN U/C WORM GEAR STUDS SHEARED, ALLOWING
U/C TO FULLY RETRACT.

PRIMARY CAUSE:

NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE PILOT IN THAT
HE DID NOT ASCERTAIN THAT THE U/C WAS FULLY
DOWN BEFORE LANDING.
