



DUTY ON WHICH ENGAGED:

Navigational exercise.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT:

Aircraft caught fire in mid-air at approx. 4000 ft. Three of the crew of four landed safely by parachute. Pilot crashed in aircraft and died instantly

PRIMARY CAUSE:

PILOT FIRED A VERY LIGHT FOR SOME UNKNOWN REASON. THE LIGHT DID NOT GO OFF AT FIRST AND UPON BEING EXAMINED IT WENT OFF IN THE COCKPIT OF THE AIRCRAFT PUTTING THE AIRCRAFT ON FIRE.

SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

THE AIRCRAFT CRASHED IN FLAMES
