Our aircraft was directly hit by (censored) and set on fire over (censored) P/O Leonard gave the order to abandon and I was first to leave the aircraft. I was informed by the Germans who captured me that W/O Wilson had been drowned and that P/O Wheelhouse had been found dead with his parachute unopened. They are buried at Bourgdun, Dieppe. I regret I have no information as to the fate of Sgt. Gough, P/O Leonard and P/O Warren.
