Flight of Spitfire V BL969 and Pilot Officer N P Murphy on 1944-06-22



On 1944-06-22, Pilot N P Murphy (Pilot Officer, RAF) with an unknown servicenumber, flew a Spitfire V with serial BL969 for this duty: Patrol. His mission was not completed. Circumstances of the aircraft loss are unknown. This aircraft was a part of squadron no. 402. The location for the map is the English Channel. Circumstances at the end of this mission for Murphy: he died, but circumstances of death are unknown. There is no commemoration location known.

There are several possibilities in investigating the flight records on Back to Normandy. All the flights are plotted on maps, sorted day by day, by squadron, by type aircraft, by year or month, by location and much more! Don't miss this!!!

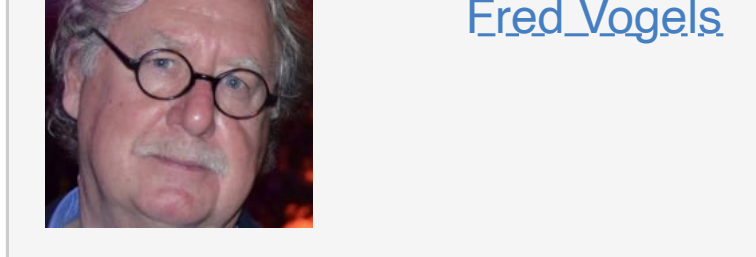
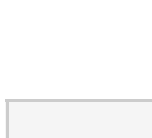


