# Crash kills army pilot

CAMP PETAWAWA (Special) — A 29-year-old army pilot, Capt. H. A. Fleury of Vancouver, was killed Monday when his light aircraft crashed on a training flight from here.

The plane, which was on its way to Trenton via Camp Borden, crashed and burned about 2 p.m. during a snowstorm at Holland Landing, about 38

miles north of Toronto.

Capt. Fleury was stationed at Camp Petawawa with the 4th Regiment RCHA Air Observation platoon troop. He is survived by his wife Doris and two children aged three and five, who are living in the married quarters here.

Investigators at the crash scene said the front end of the aircraft had been destroyed by fire.
